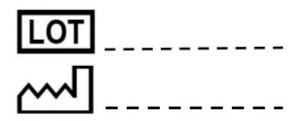

MEANS OF CONTROL

Firstly, IQC will take sample to monitor (ISO 2859, G1) the knitting gloves performance. They check the gloves on hand former, and monitor the glove color, total length, weight, visual defect Ext. If find abnormal will follow the non-conforming procedure to handle it.

Then, IPQC will check the product after dipping, they will check the total length, palm width, weight, and monitor the visual defects and performance, example: taste, dipping position Ext.

The next is packing process, QA will monitor the logo, bag, carton, label Ext. If ok, the glove will be send to warehouse.

In warehouse, FQC will check the final product.

This is a strict monitor procedure. We pick out the defects around 2%-4% in this process. We can ensure the quality according it.

Then, we will ship the gloves to our customer site.

For EN388 test, we have been certified by CTC, we have test machine in our laboratory. When we beginning a new order, we will test the gloves firstly. We also have the testing regularly during the production process. The testing includes abrasion(test every one year), cut, tear, puncture.

For EN ISO 21420 test, we asked our vendor to according to the request, and they cannot use any materials which contain Hazardous Substances. For each style, we send the final gloves to third party to monitor it regularly
