Chemicals to be avoided should not be present in the product in unbound, bound or natural form. Concentrations under the threshold value of 0.1% are accepted. It is assumed that the information in the A20 list is known.

Providing incorrect information can have legal consequences.



It is hereby confirmed that Fiberon does not use the chemicals listed above in the production of the olefin based composite deck boards. Fiberon however does use recycled wood and resin sources; so contamination is theoretically possible although highly unlikely.
